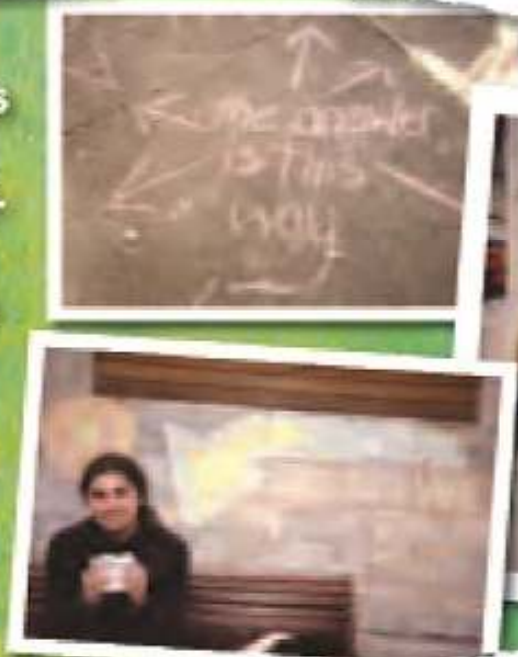

A grass-roots, face-to-face, gentle-but-radical, Christ-inspired approach to compassionate community work. A small group of participants from any (or no) faith tradition explore spirituality, community and compassion together through this two week residential experience.

COMMUNITY ORIENTATION COURSE

The course includes input, in a variety of styles, from local people who are exploring non-violence, food ethics and environmental issues, and those who work alongside Indigenous groups, migrants, refugees and others who are struggling with serious disadvantages and significant disabilities. Participants live together in a 'one star' community facility. There is no set cost – instead a group cost-sharing exercise helps the participants decide on payments based on individual financial means.
